**GPS Coordinates:** LAT 35°59.9258' LONG W85°11.847E -OR- LAT 35° 59'59" LONG W85 11' 41"

**DIRECTIONS:** From the North I-64 (Indiana), exit 105, Condon (May 1985) go 17 miles to 2<sup>nd</sup> light after crossing the bridge and turn left. From I-65 exit 102 (May 3171) go west 23 miles. (3171 turns into 448 at US60) continue on 448 for 8 miles to 1251 (keep left), at 7<sup>th</sup> stop light turn right. From Louisville take US 31W to 1258 (turn right) to 448 (turn right) to 1051 (keep left), at 7<sup>th</sup> stop light turn right.
