This year the Kentucky Derby Rally will be held at Good Ol' Days RV park. While the address is Versailles, Ky the campground is actually closer to Midway, Kentucky. The owner, Mr. John Dance, has agreed to provide us with full hook up sites for only \$25/night. This is a beautiful setting located on one of the most famous and scenic roads in the State of Kentucky. We are only minutes to many of the big name horse farms and only 10 - 15 minutes to Keeneland Racecourse. The RV park is nicely landscaped and includes a small fishing lake with a gazebo and a small vineyard. We will have access to an enclosed meeting area and there is even an old tobacco barn which has been converted to a restaurant, which may be open in May.
